Diverse Clinical Sites

The CSUN Athletic Training Program has over **20 clinical sites** that will provide practical application opportunities for students to apply knowledge and skills learned in the classroom. These clinical sites range from **Division I Athletic Programs** and **local Community Colleges/High Schools to Physician's Offices/Hospitals and Outpatient Rehabilitation Clinics**. Experienced preceptors at each clinical site will supervise and mentor Athletic Training Students as they provide patient care to a diverse patient population.

Observation Hours:

- Recommended completion of 50 observation hours under a certified Athletic Trainer.
