#### Who we are:

Pre-Health students at University of Iowa have decided to organize the Second Annual Pre-Health Conference to help undergraduate students network with current health professionals and professional schools, explore career options with corporations and healthcare facilities, and discover new fields that interest them in healthcare. We've selected hard working and qualified students to help support and create this conference. While this is the second year that the conference will be held virtually, it is the goal of the University of Iowa Pre-Health Planning Committee for the conference to become an in-person annual event, attracting pre-health students and guest speakers from all across the nation. #### Where and when is the conference:

# Why we are contacting the speakers:

We are searching for speakers in various health fields and/or representatives from graduate/professional schools who would be willing to attend the conference and

There will be sessions dedicated to professional school admissions, application advice, career opportunities, and many more. ## What the speakers will talk about: (For individuals)

The information we are hoping to have speakers share includes sharing their health field journey, how they got into their field, what their graduate/professional school experience was like, tips for undergraduate students and for those applying soon, advice for going through the application and interview processes, and anything else that would be valuable to share with students.
