Students attending the UPS-AY program will have the opportunity to apply for the Undergraduate Plummer Scholars Plus (UPS+) summer program which is a distinct track within the larger UPS-AY program specifically for outstanding students with a GPA of at least 3.2, living in U.S. mainland and plans to take the MCAT in the next 12-months. UPS+ is an intensive week-long summer program in June and July 2026 at one of our three campuses in AZ, MN, or FL.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Pre-medical undergraduate students are planning to apply to medical school. Incoming freshmen are not eligible, but we welcome applications as rising sophomores next year.
