In 2005 he joined what is now Springer Nature as a manuscript editor at Nature Materials, and moved on to Nature Communications in 2012. Having held several managerial positions there, he became the journal's Executive Editor in 2015. In 2016, Joerg was appointed PLOS ONE's Editor-in-Chief.
